



KIWI AVOIDANCE TRAINING EVENT EMERGENCY PROCEDURES PLAN

‘What to do and what to say’

Ring 111 (ask for Police, Fire or Ambulance)

1. Give your exact location – be exact.

- House number
- Nearest road
- Rapid number
- GPS coordinates (if in the bush)

2. If there is an accident;

- Make situation safe for you and others
- Apply first aid if needed
- Say; how serious, number of people involved, types of injuries.
- Do not mention names
- Do you need an ambulance or a helicopter

3. If there is a fire (if small enough use extinguisher from your vehicle)

- Say; what is the size of the fire
- What is burning
- Weather conditions

4. If there is a flood or tsunami

- Move away from all waterways and move to higher ground immediately.

5. If there is an earthquake

- Move away from any objects that can fall on you (away from trees, poles etc.).
- If within a building move under a table or doorway.

**DO NOT PANIC. STAY CALM.
PROVIDE CLEAR & CONCISE LOCATIONS & DIRECTIONS.**

**Let affected people know. This may include:
next of kin, the client (StK, Regional Council, DOC).**
